

例句: <u>Crime</u> and poverty are epidemic in the country.

译文:犯罪和贫穷如瘟疫一般在这个国家肆虐。



词汇: incriminate v控告

例句: Among the most <u>incriminating</u> documents cited in the order are memoranda and emails from the bank's attorneys, who allegedly advised that wire instructions should not identify the names of Iranian clients because that would trigger scrutiny in New York.

译文:报告引用的最能将渣打治罪的文件之一,是渣打律师团队的备忘录和电子邮件,他们涉嫌建议在电汇指令中不列明伊朗客户的名称,因为这可能触发来自纽约监管当局的检查。
